

TARGET 1: CAREER PLANNING

- So I'm graduating from college, now what?

- What is strategic planning and how do I effectively use it to plan my career?
- What are industry pros and cons to consider while planning?

TARGET 2: FINANCIAL PLANNING

- What's the difference between being a salaried employee and a freelancer?
- What's more common in tv/film, salaried or freelance?
- If I'm freelance, how do I prepare a personal budget if my income will vary month to month?
- What are some financial decisions I can make now to help me prepare to be freelance?
- Should I be thinking about retirement already? Why?

- How do I market myself when I do not have "real" tv or film experience?
- Where should education go on my resume?
- What's the difference between a connection and a mentor?
- I met someone who I really believe can help me in this industry. How do I ask that person to be my mentor?

- What should my mentor expect from me as a mentee?

- What are the entry-level positions in tv and film?
- What does a Production Assistant do?

- How do I advance beyond entry level?
